



Immunization Requirements for 2018-2019

Varicella vaccine – Children who have not had the chicken pox are required to show proof of varicella immunization. Schools will not accept a parent's report that their child has had the chicken pox.

6th Grade Vaccines – Tdap vaccine – The Tdap vaccine will be required for students 11 years and older (if it has been 5 years or longer since last vaccine dose).

Meningococcal vaccine - MCV4 vaccine will be required for students 11 years and older. **HPV** is recommended

Kindergarten Vaccines – Any student entering kindergarten must receive their 5 year vaccines which include **Dtap-5** doses, **Polio-4** doses, **MMR-2**doses, **Hep B-3** doses, **Varicella-1-2** doses.

****PLEASE MAKE SURE YOUR CHILDS IMMUNIZATION RECORDS ARE UP TO DATE AND PROVIDE A COPY PRIOR TO STARTING THE 2017-2018 SCHOOL YEAR. IF YOU ARE UNSURE, CHECK WITH THE NURSES OFFICE TO SEE WHAT WE HAVE ON FILE.**

****IF YOU HAVE CHOSEN NOT TO VACCINATE YOUR CHILD, YOU MUST PROVIDE THE SCHOOL WITH A SIGNED EXCEPTION FORM WHICH WILL BE KEPT IN THE NURSE'S OFFICE ON FILE AND NEEDS TO BE UPDATED YEARLY.**

NOTE: All immunizations must be up to date by the start of school or your child will not be allowed to attend.
